Our Plan to Regather: Guidelines for Group Meetings

Groups may request to meet on campus within the following Guidelines. Call the Church Office to check availability at (770) 479-2502. Please note that Sunday mornings are dedicated to Worship Services.

Guidelines for Group meetings

- Plan and promote the practice of safety precautions:
 1. Practice social distancing, that is, maintain at least six feet between people not living in the same household.
 2. Require the use of cloth face coverings among participants [cloth face coverings should not be placed on children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing or is unconscious, or anyone who is incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove it without assistance.]
 3. Stay home when sick.
- Use contact-free greetings. Discourage physical contact between attendees while on the CFUMC campus.
- No food or beverage service is allowed during this phase. Encourage participants to bring their own drinks.
- Limit any exchange or sharing of materials or supplies.
- Please limit your activities to areas reserved for your meeting space. Other groups may also be utilizing the facility concurrently.
- Maintain a record of attendance for your meeting and participant contact information.
- Contact the Church Office if a group meeting participant is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19.
