### Our Plan to Regather: Group Meetings

As of April 25, 2021

Groups may request to meet on campus within the following Guidelines. The Group Leader is responsible for communicating and ensuring Guidelines are followed by participants. Call the Church Office to check availability at 770-479-2502.

#### Guidelines for Group Meetings:

The Group Leader is responsible for communicating to group members and for ensuring Guidelines are followed:

- **Practice physical distancing**, that is, maintain at least six feet between people not living in the same household.

\*Maintain seating arrangements for required physical distancing\*

- **Require the use of face coverings among participants** [face coverings should not be placed on children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing or is unconscious, or anyone who is incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the covering without assistance.]
- **Use contact-free greetings.** Discourage physical contact between attendees while on the church campus.
- **Only individual pre-packaged food items are allowed** during this phase. Encourage participants to bring their own drinks.
- **Please limit your activities to areas reserved** for your meeting space. Other groups may also be utilizing the facility concurrently.

We are continuing to perform enhanced sanitation procedures throughout the church buildings. A CFUMC staff representative will be available while your group is on campus to ensure a positive experience and to assist in responding to any issues that may arise.
