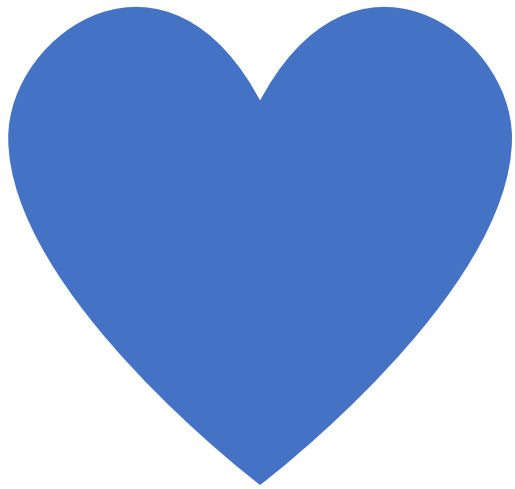

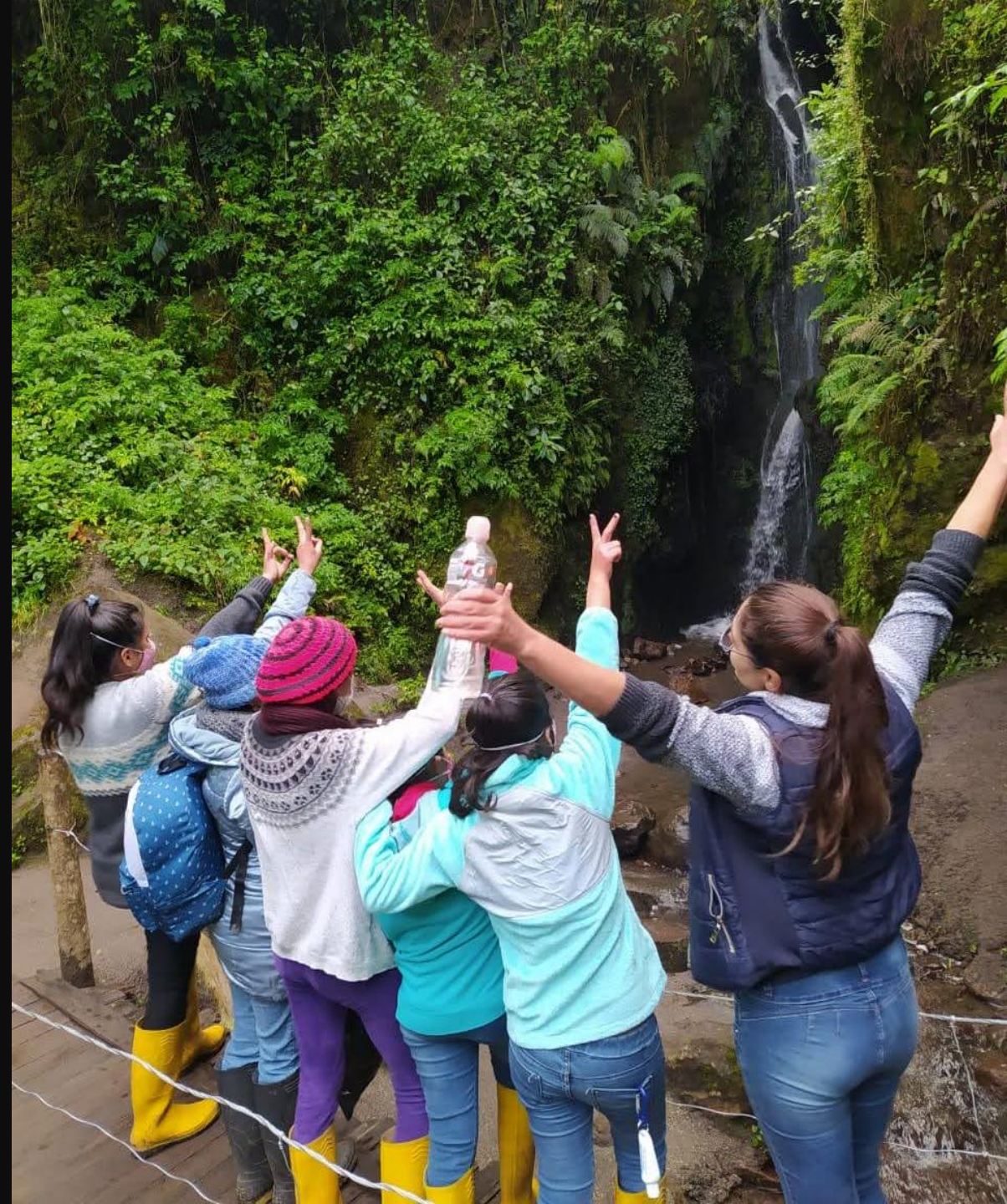


LIVES SAVED

In 2020 we shelter 6 girls who were rescued from sexual abuse and sexual exploitation. The ages were between 9 and 15 years old.

Currently we are providing shelter for 13 girls and 3 babies, ages 8 through 17. These girls come from different parts of the country and one from abroad. All of them suffered abuse, negligence and in some cases, they were sold for sexual exploitation by their parents or criminals.

In the 10 years Dunamis has been actively working, we have helped over 100 girls with our workshops. Most of them accepted Jesus Christ as their savior, this is what makes our work worthy.



MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS





During 2020 we have had several conflicts and scenarios that have endangered our lives. That is why during 2020 and 2021, our goal is to increase security within Dunamis facilities. As you can remember, in our letter of June 2020, Boris Salinas and his family were attacked by armed criminals in their home, luckily the only thing that was stolen were material objects, but our fighting spirit grew more, and God has taken away the fear of continuing to work for his work. We have made some changes to the security of Casa Zoe and Dunamis.

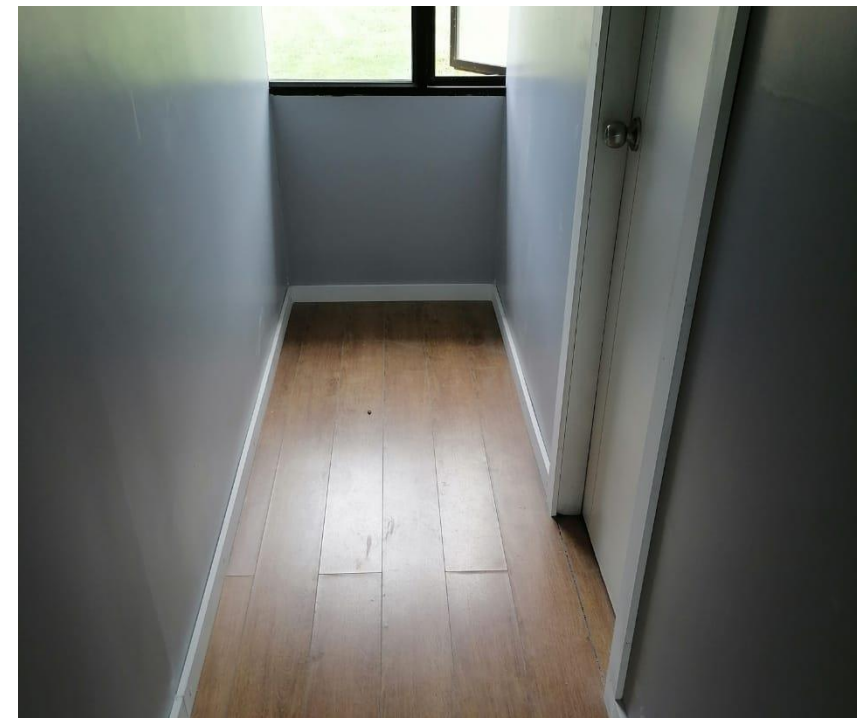


Inside Casa Zoe, we have added door and window security systems, motion sensors and an SOS app to help our educators feel safer. Sometimes the girls can be conflictive with each other and with the educators, however we know that God is working in them. We want everyone at Dunamis to feel secure and confident in God and in their work.





Part of our cover letter is excellence and good presentation. We have made adjustments inside and outside Casa Zoe and Dunamis. As you know, Dunamis had an accident and the girls' rooms were consumed by a fire. Thanks to your support, we were able to recover the rooms in less than 2 months and restore the house. It is these miracles that make us believe that God loves these girls, and that no matter that the enemy wants to play with our minds, he always blesses his children.

Dunamis Foundation's program Casa Zoe, is a protection home for underage girls victims of sexual exploitation, sexual abuse and violence. Our program consist of 3 main departments:

- Psychology
- Social Work
- Education

They are all coordinated by Cristina Enriquez, our program coordinator.

As this is a private protection home, we have no monetary support from any public entity, but we can take part in the benefits of a protection home which includes: medical aid, legal aid and more.

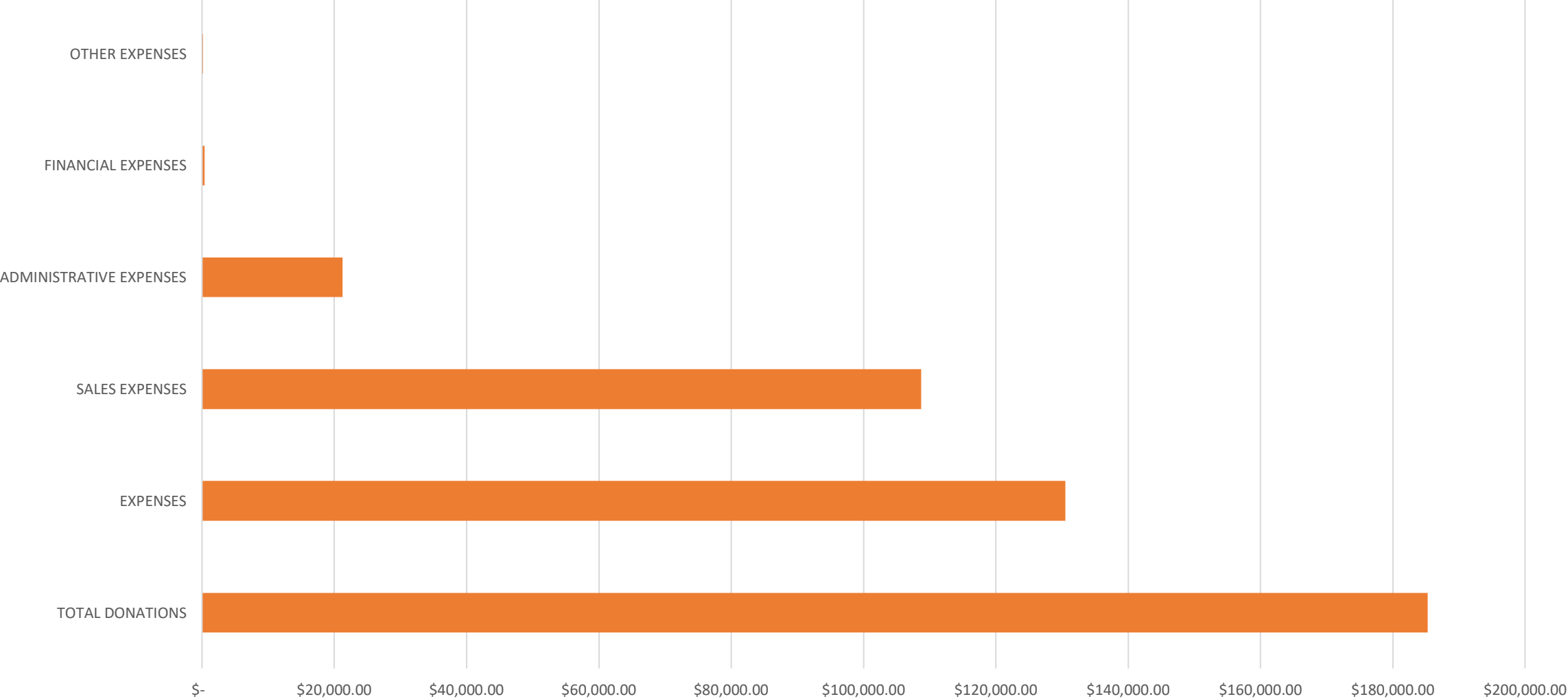

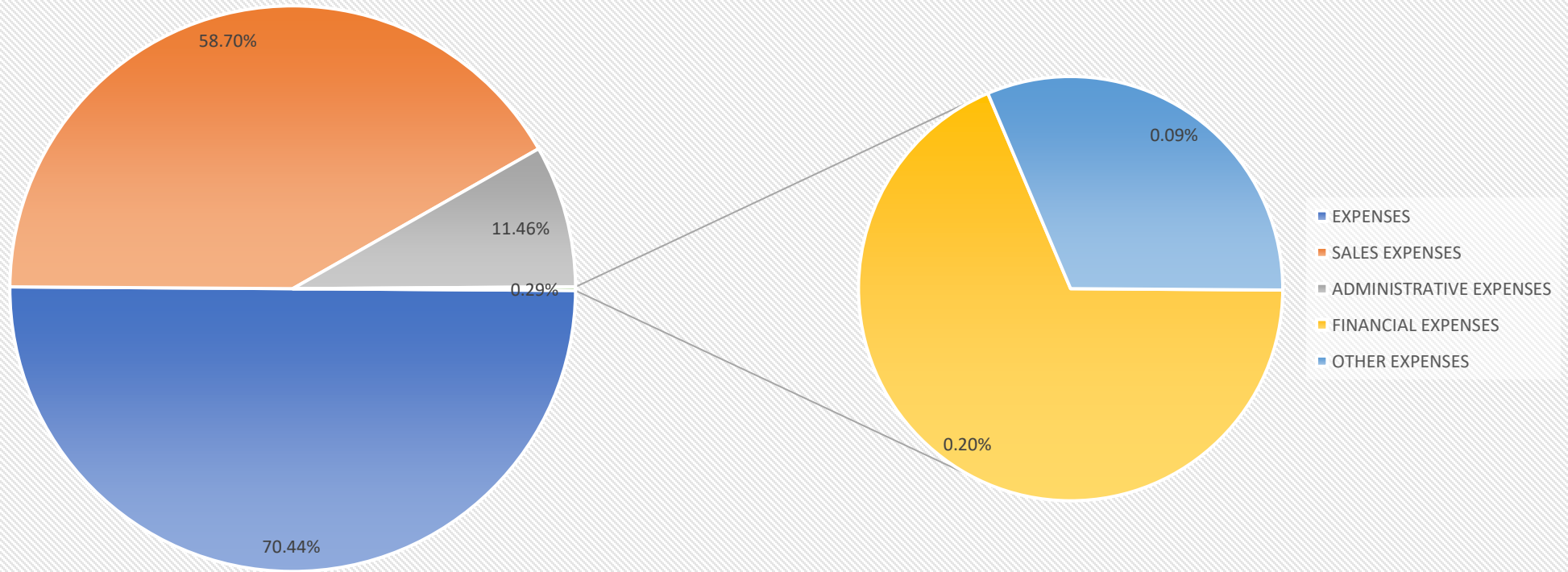

2020 PIE CHART




